

FILTER POCKET FACE MASK PATTERN

NO ELASTIC REQUIRED

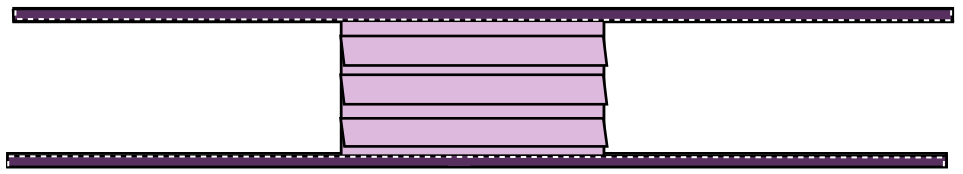
1

Fold the larger back pieces in half lengthwise and press. You will have two pieces that are 9" by 4".



3

Sew the side seams with a 1/4" seam allowance. Do not sew the top and bottom. Turn right side out and press.



MATERIALS

- 100% cotton fabric
- Contrast fabric for the back
- 1/2" binding or bias tape

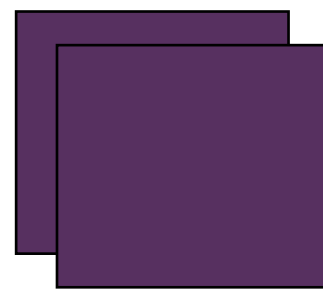
1/4" seam allowance included in the measurements



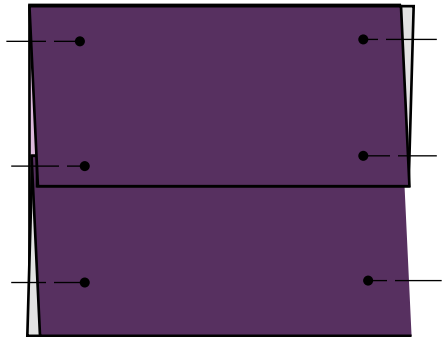
TIES(2) - 44" x 2"



FRONT - 9" x 7"



BACK (2) - 9" x 8"

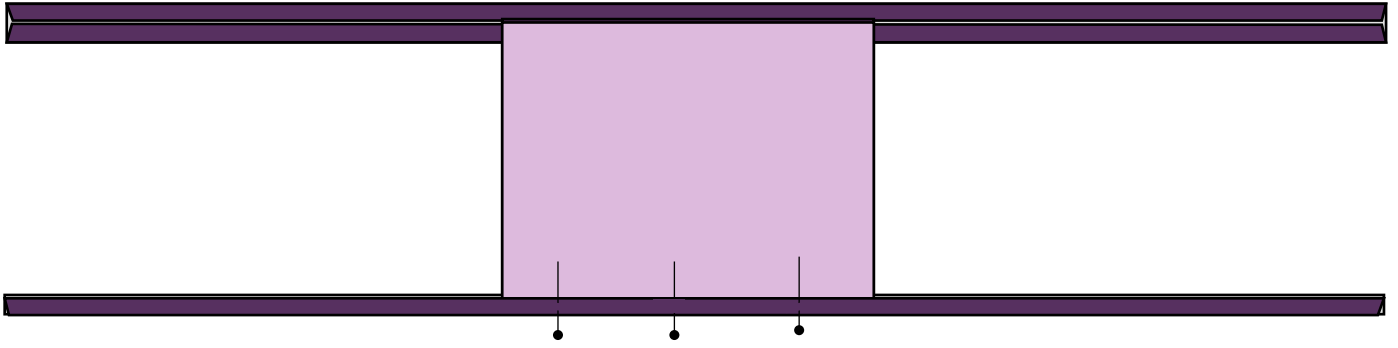
Pin the folded back pieces to the right side of the front piece. Match up the raw edges at the top and bottom of the mask. The fold edge of the back pieces will overlap about 1", creating a pocket.

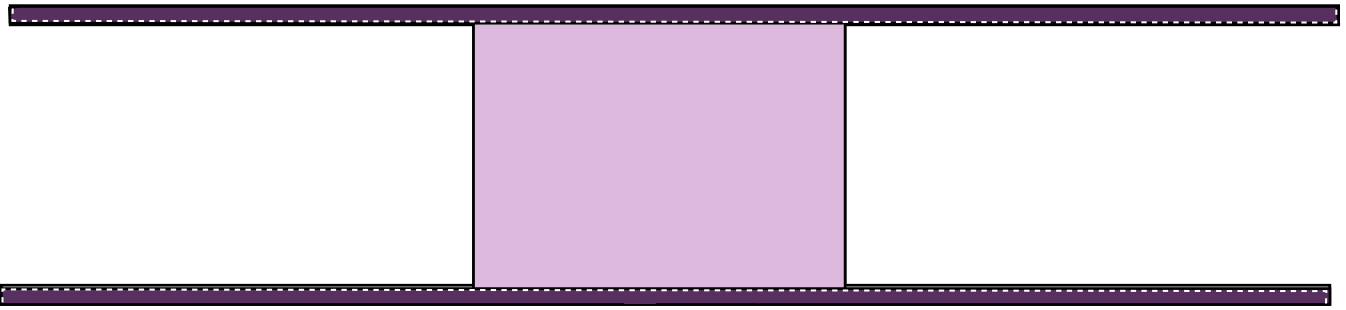
Fold the long edges of the binding over so they almost meet in the middle. Press. Fold in half again to complete the double-folded binding.



5 Pin mask into the middle of the binding.



6 Sew close to the open edge of the binding, sandwiching the mask inside. Fold under the binding edges and catch in the same seam. Backstitch. Complete at top and bottom of the mask.



7 Create 3 pleats about 1/2" each, all facing downward. Pin and stitch well.
